## **Emergency Evacuation and National Emergency Planning**

National planning aims to define and coordinate rescue operations and provide assistance when faced with a disaster.

These national contingency plans are broken down by type of risk and related to specific areas, identified with the help of the scientific community, according to the danger of a particular event and the vulnerability of a particular territory.

A national emergency plan ensures the mobilisation of all services as a single organisation of emergency, which combines central and local institutions, volunteer organisations and private enterprises, foreign countries and if necessary, to give first aid and assistance to citizens.

Civil protection activities also benefit from the contribution of professional orders and boards as well as private companies, especially those linked to strategic sectors such as communications, transport, and essential services networks.

The most recent documents on risk assessment should be in compliance with the European Commission's requirements.
